1. Auction Guideline

- 1. The auction will be categorised into the following categories:
 - a. Overseas Category
 - b. Category A (iSU internal overseas)
 - c. Category B (iSU Internal active players)
 - d. Category C (iSU others)
- 2. A team can retain a maximum of 2 players; this rule does not apply to the Overseas Category of players.
- 3. In the auction, the category A, B, and C Players have uploaded their recent picture to their profile.
- 4. A maximum of 22 players (including overseas) can be a part of a team. With a minimum of 15 players.
- 5. The auction will be done separately for both overseas and domestic players.
- 6. The auction will be only done once for both overseas and domestic players. (Total 2 auctions)
- 7. Internal trade will be allowed, except for the overseas category. The deadline for internal trading is 11.59 pm on 15th April 2024.
- 8. Internal trading can be done only when the buying team has more wallet amount then the selling team.
- 9. If a player is not auctioned, they will not be considered an auctioned player of the iHL season 2024. The auctioned player rules and regulations will not apply to them.
- 10. A minimum of 1 overseas player has to be bought by a team.
- 11. A maximum of 1 Category A player can be bought by a team.
- 12. The team's responsible for ensuring that overseas players are available during the tournament.
 - a. Tentative Slot A 1st to 12th May 2024
 - b. Tentative Slot B 20th May to 3rd June 2024
- 13. No players (both overseas and domestic) will be allowed to play in the tournament if he not been auctioned during the auction.
- 14. During the auction, players' profiles will be shown randomly.
- 15. Corporate team's overseas players' suggestions
 - a. INFOSYS -4 Players (Point of Contact Chinmaya Patra)
 - b. DCB-4 (Point of Contact Chinmaya Patra)
 - c. SOA-2 (Point of Contact Pradyut Mishra)

- d. S3C-2 (Point of Contact Pradyut Mishra)
- e. KT Global 1(Point of Contact Devkalyan Sahani)
- f. Railway 1 (Point of Contact Chinmaya Patra/ Debraj)
- g. TCS-1(Point of Contact Pradyut Mishra)
- h. CCC-2(Point of Contact Pradyut Mishra)
- i. IDFC-2 (Point of Contact Chinmaya Patra/Ashutosh)
- j. Union Club-2 (Point of Contact Chinmaya Patra)
- 16. The total wallet amount will be 100 Cr for Category A, B, and C Players auction and 30 Cr for overseasCategory Players.
- 17. The action bidding will start from 10 Lakh for a player.
- 18. For every category of players, there is a different minimum bidding slab as follows:
 - a. Overseas 1 Cr
 - b. Category A 75 Lakhs
 - c. Category B 50 Lakhs
 - d. Category C 10 Lakhs
- 19. The minimum bidding can increment with a minimum of 10 Lakhs.
- 20. No money can be added to the wallet of any team during Category A, B, C or Overseas Category Auctions or when the internal trading window is open.
- 21. Approved Dyus Court staff/ iServeU support staff can participate in the auction as Category A, B, and C Players.
- 22. After the auction to the end of the tournament, no overseas player can be replaced or changed by a team.
- 23. During the auction, if a network issue arises the bidding will begin from where it was discontinued.

2. Impact Player Guideline

- 1. In playing 11 of a team, a maximum of 2 overseas players, including the Impact player, should be in a session.
- 2. As an Impact player, the Overseas Category player can be replaced by an Overseas Category player, and the same applies to Category A, B, C players.
- 3. Only one impact player can be substituted for a team in a match.
- 4. At any point, a Maximum of 3 Overseas Category players can be present in the field, including 1 Overseas player as substitute player. The substitute player can be the wicketkeeper.
- 5. Once an impact player is replaced, he can not come back to the field.
- 6. The player list has to be submitted within 5 minutes of the toss.
- 7. The impact player can be introduced at any point in time.
- 8. If a player retires hurt, Impact Player can be introduced only at the end of the over in progress and is eligible to bat. In any situation, only 11 players can bat.
- 9. For dispute, the umpire will refer to the IPL Impact player guideline.

- 10. A total of 2 reviews are allowed per match per team.
- 11. If the the Overseas Category player is selected to and accepts the offer letter, he will be moved to the domestic category player; this rule applies until the start of the first match.

3. Umpire and Scorer Guideline

- 1. OCA Umpires and Score only can be a part of the tournament. The Franchise /Participating team can't recommend the Umpire.
- 2. Chuck bowling is not allowed in the tournament.
- 3. The tournament will follow the IPL Playing guidelines.

4. Non-Auctioned Players Guideline

1. A maximum of 20 Players can be on the ground in the team's dugout.

5. Rain Impact Guideline

- 1. If the game is paused or delayed due to rain, the first 30 minutes will be the waiting period, and then for every 30 minutes, 5 overs will be deducted; this will apply only to the match where the rain is impacted.
- 2. The match ending time is 11pm.
- 3. Points of the match will be shared if the minimum 10 overs is not played by either batting team.
- 4. If a team plays an inning, the target can be revised using the D/L Method.
- 5. If any playing 11 are absent within the first 6 overs, he can't be part of the match, and the player will be replaced as an impact player.

6. Fixture Guideline

- 1. Once the fixture is published, it can't be changed.
- 2. Every team will get an equal opportunity to play during the day and night slot.

7. Players Guideline

1. Cricket studs/spikes are mandatory for all playing 11 players.

2. The white pad is not allowed.

8. Dispute Resolution Guideline

1. In case of dispute, it will be raised to the rulebook committee.

9. Others

- 1. The captain will ensure dugout and campus cleanliness.
- 2. Fairplay will be given to the team based on the dugout and campus cleanliness.
- 3. At least 5 -10 members from the other two participating as the viewer should be present. This rule is applicable for both matches.
- 4. KIT's responsibility is to have the captain play teams during possessions.
